Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of services, but the same God; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

St. Augustine's offers opportunities for all ages to learn and grow their faith within community:

- through study, questioning and reflection
- participation in liturgical and spiritual practices
- discernment on how to integrate faith through action into daily life

Children's Formation: From September to May, children ages 3 - 6th grade are invited to attend Sunday School during the 9:30 a.m. worship service, leaving after *The Opening Prayer* and returning during *The Passing of the Peace*. We worship, share, learn, reflect and play together in order to nurture a relationship with God and one another. The curriculum is flexible and provides for diverse experiences to meet the evolving needs of our children.

Children also have the opportunity to participate in seasonal events, such as the Back-to-School Backpack Blessing and the annual Christmas pageant, and they can serve as worship leaders throughout the year.

Confirmation: Grades 7 and above are invited to participate in our Confirmation program. In coordination with St. Luke's, St. Mark's and St. Matthew's Episcopal churches in Evanston, youth gather to explore, to question, and to



grow in faith. Our next session will be offered in 2024-2025.
