

The Organ at St. Augustine's Episcopal Church, Wilmette, Illinois

Our organ at St. A's was originally built in 1955 as Opus 8724 of the M. P. Möller Company of Hagerstown, Maryland. The instrument contained 17 ranks pipes (991 pipes, 3 divisions, 2 manuals, 19 stops and 15 registers) distributed over two manuals and pedal. The original specification is below:

In 1997 the organ was rebuilt and enlarged by Berghaus Organ Company of Bellwood Illinois. The current disposition is 25 ranks (1,462 pipes, 3 divisions, 2 manuals, 30 stops and 20 registers), still distributed over 2 manuals and pedal.
